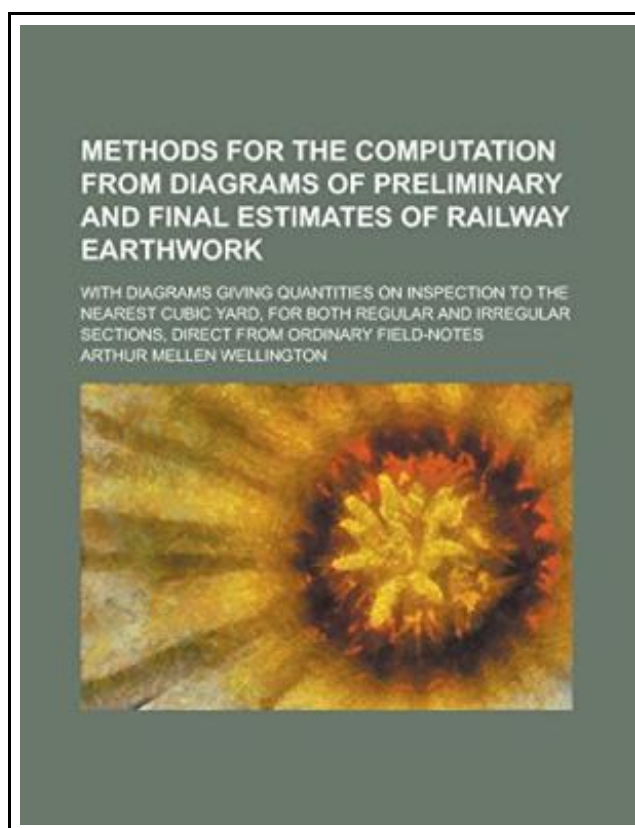

When one end-section is three-level, as must frequently be the case, the quantity for each section obtained as above is equal to the quantity equation (22), + 16.7, the difference between of the solidity of the grade-prism (50 yards), which is actually deducted in equation (21), and of that solidity (66.7 yards), which strict theory requires to be deducted. Also, when Plate X. is in use, by the rule of paragraph 109, for another road-bed than 18 feet, the quantity 8, as taken off must be corrected by two-thirds only of the correction in Table II. (plus 16.7 as before) to have it equal to the quantity obtained as above:...
